1. General Terms

- 1.1. I understand that I/my child/children/my students should not participate in this event/ events unless I am/he or she is/they are in a fit state physically and mentally to compete the event safely. I acknowledge that if I am aware of an existing medical condition and/or uncertain of my/his/her/their state of fitness then a medical practitioner should be consulted prior to participating.
- 1.2. I consent to receiving any medical treatment including ambulance transportation in circumstances where a coach determines as a result of a health incident during or after the service provided or event.
- 1.3. I /my child/my student's is/are following COVID medical advice. If feeling unwell or in close contact will not attend any services
- 1.4. I have disclosed, provided or attached to my enrolment details of any medical, physical and behavioural conditions from which I suffer that might affect my performance or be relevant if medical treatment is needed, including any allergies or injuries. I have supplied an emergency contact name and number.
- 1.5. Handball Australia is not liable for any lost personal possessions.
- 1.6. Although Safety precautions are undertaken by coaches and organizers (such as cones, first aid, staff training, safety instructions are a service to me and other participants) it is a requirement that participants need to act responsibly and sensibly in events and any other service.
- 1.7. My service registration is not transferable to any other person or other event/service. Any attempt to transfer my entry or allow another person to participate under my name may result in cancellation without refund, insurance being deemed void and inability to enter further services or events.
- 1.8. You, your child/children/OSH/School are insured with Public Liability, Products Liability, property damage and Professional Indemnity under Handball Australia underwriter Sportcover Australia Pty Ltd. I understand that insurance cover in our coaching services may not cover me for all injury, loss or damage sustained by me.

4. Competitions and Tournaments

4.1 Format


This is a 4 square combined school, teams and individual competition. A multiple competition format. The format caters for different standards, ages and different student numbers. You can win both individually (example best student on their court) and for your school (XYZ school ranked 2nd best). You can win multiple prizes, not everyone will receive a prize, you must earn it. Divisions are split into years (year 1 -12) and standards (Beginners, intermediate and Advanced) Due to numbers divisions may merge together

4.2 Awards

Lots of awards including trophies, medallions, prizes, certificates and Handball are awarded for best players in each year, best school or team, sportsmanship, leadership, captancy, improvement, outstanding achievement and best team support/cheering

4.3 Rules

1	Serve	King serves. No slack/ mean serves	If a slack/mean serve is done receiver must yell out "slack or indecent" before hitting ball and ball must be served again to the same person. Receiver must be ready to receive the ball, if not ready it's a slack and ball must be served again
2	Full	Full your out	Full or Overs means ball is hit over the line into another person's square before landing in your square. You are out. There will be no Full plays or plays on's or forgotten's
3	Lines	Replay	Ball hits any line replay the point.
4	Rolls	You're out	
5	Headers	Allowed – Full or 1 bounce	No Footsies, hips or other body parts allowed
6	Elimination	3 square elimination. Only King goes to Dunce	If you get out from Q, J or D you go to reserve. Only King goes to Dunce
7	Court Setup		<p>K = King Q = Queen J = Jack D = Dunce</p> <p>R = Reserve or Res</p> <p>Each square size approx. 2.2 x 2.2 Meters. 4 square entire court approx. 19.36 Square meters</p>
8	In toes or interference.	Interference from another player or ball from another court	If a ball, player or object is in the way. Player must yell "In toes or interference" and point is replayed.
9	Poison	Other people can't hit into your square or they are out	Allowed once per player during the tournament for 2 mins. Other players can't hit ball into your square until you are ready. Example tie your shoe lace, get a drink or first aid. Must be a legitimate reason. Other players can group vote to allow or disallow. Game continues without your square in play. When player's move up they miss skip your square. Yell "unpoison" or "medicine" to come back into the game

10	Savies	Save a person from getting out	Yell "Savies" to save a person that was meant to be out and continue play. Player does a full, miss hits ball, hits ball out, then you can hit the ball. Player doesn't even have to hit the ball, you can hit the ball for them. You can hit the ball into their square or your square and its play on. Ball cant bounce twice
11	Treetops	Hit ball high into the air	Is off. You can hit the ball as high (and you don't have to yell treetops) as you want or as low as you want
12	Ghosties	Allowed to step into another person court	This is when you bork or pretend to hit the ball but don't and the ball goes into another person's square. This will confuse the other player and hopefully they get out. You are also allowed to have one foot stepping in another person's square. As long as you don't interfere with that person. You can step out of bounds
13	Teams	This is allowed	There will be circumstances where the same team mates or school mates will be on the same court. This will give them a competitive advantage. They cannot openly discuss tactics to gesture this. But they won't try and get each other out to support their school/team ranking
14	Start position	Court start position can be done multiple ways to make it fair	Staff may say first to square, by Height, pre-ranking, DOB, First name, or staff chooses random order
15	No other rules are allowed unless majority vote	A list of Common rules that are not allowed	No death rally, no pass backs, faults, grabsies. No Scoops, King choice, Old ace. If majority of students vote to change a rule, we will, its your game, we can do any rules you want

4.4 Sportsmanship Steps

Step	Name	Description	Full Detail and Examples
1	Player to Player	Two Players have a healthy discussion	Both players involved in the last shot have a healthy discussion as to what might have happened without raising your voice or bullying.

2	Replay point or group Vote/ Majority Vote	Players can replay point or all players can vote on what happened and who's out	If both players are unsure, the whole group of players can replay the point or do a group vote on who's out, where the ball landed or what happened.
3	Staff	Staff decides	Unsure and need help put your hand up and talk to a friendly staff member to help
4	Constant problems	Modify Rules	If staff are constantly been called to your court with disputes, crying, bullying or cheating we will modify the rules, verbal warning of players, give yellow (10 mins) and Red cards (permanently removed from competition)

4.5 **Etiquette**

- (a) My child and i will abide by Handball Australia competition rules, etiquette, terms and conditions
- (b) The four Sportsmanship Steps will be adhered to by all players and Staff
- (c) Gamesmanship is not allowed - Opposite to sportsmanship. On purpose trying to psychologically or mentally upset opponent to gain advantage.
- (d) Students and parents can cheer and be positive. Any biased opinions, negative or rude remarks, parents will be asked to leave and their children will be banned from any future Handball Australia service and products.
- (e) Spectators must maintain a 2 meter distance from the players and courts
- (f) We try and teach students Sportsmanship steps to resolve disputes. However, parents, staff and coaches may umpire each court if needed. This helps maintain order of a court. If there is constant issue's, contact Staff and we assist you

5. **Rewards**

Accept rewards such as prizes, ice blocks, sweets, lollies, toys, soft drinks or chips. In circumstances where there maybe allergy issues or your child is not allowed food, please inform Handball Australia

6. **Refunds, Credits, Makeups, Cancellations and Transfers**

- 6.1. Group lessons & Privates. Service is transferable to the following term or sibling. Cancellation must be made within 1 hours of the lesson otherwise full price will be paid and no makeup will be given. Transfer to another class/day/time during the term period is

permitted pending vacancies. Group privates: If one person cancels and the other student attends, its considered a completed lesson and no makeup is given.

- 6.2. School Sport: On rainy days, away or cancel a makeup or credit of lesson will be given.
- 6.3. Handball Australia Holiday Camps: are on rain, hail or shine. We provide a full wet weather program. Including Bus transport, excursions, Amazing Race, indoor Handball Australia & sports, movies, Strike/AMF Bowling, Laser Skirmish and Theory is conducted in the clubhouse. If your child is sick or injured and have a casual booking you may cancel (1 hour notification must be given) and rebook another day or credited to another camp.
- 6.4. Refunds and/or credits will be given for person injured, excessive rain delays or by government mandated COVID restrictions

7. Membership

- 7.1. Handball Australia is not responsible, (in whole or part) for the loss of a provided membership card.
- 7.2. An administration fee of \$5 will be charged for a replacement membership card where loss or damage occurs.
- 7.3. Any stars which are lost in conjunction with a membership card may or may not be replaced at the sole discretion of the staff of Handball Australia. They will start from 0 stars. Handball Australia reserves the right to refuse partial or whole replacement of any stars lost in conjunction with the membership in question. The situation of each individual will be handled on a case by case basis.
- 7.4. Handball Australia is not responsible for any loss or damage caused to the individual or individuals associated with the Star Rewards program – including, but not limited to students, individuals, parents and guardians. Handball Australia reserves the right to modify this policy with or without the prior communication to its clients.

8. Star Rewards

- 8.1. A membership in the form of a lanyard and star rewards card has been provided to your child as a participant of Handball Australia and its programs including but not limited to Handball Australia coaching, clinics, competitions and or holiday camps
- 8.2. The membership card distributed provides a medium for which your child can earn 'stars' as a form of positive reinforcement for their efforts throughout programs listed above.
- 8.3. 'Stars' earned on a membership can be traded in for prizes of monetary value subject to availability and stock.
- 8.4. 'Stars' are non transferrable, meaning they cannot be shared, distributed, moved and or used with, by or to another individual. Handball Australia reserves the right to remove single or multiple stars from an individual's membership if they deem an individual's behaviour detracts from the participation of others.

- 8.5. If an individual forgets, loses, defaces, and or uses another individual's membership card or stars, Handball Australia reserves the right to refuse to give stars to an individual until the problem is rectified. We will write names on memberships
- 8.6. If kids loose there stars they start from 0. A strong lesson in responsibility and sportsmanship.
- 8.7. If children and caught cheating they go back to 0 stars

9. Prizes

Any advertised prizes incorporated in the Star Rewards trade and save program are subject to availability and stock. Handball Australia reserves the right to alter the value of prizes without prior notice to clients and individuals

10. Enrollments and Discounts

- 10.1. Enrolments: Must be made on our website. If you cannot process payment please request and invoice
- 10.2. Discounts: Only apply via payments online, with the code and by the due date.

11. Extra Supervision

This must be booked on our website. If your child is away or does not need this service we must be notified. Failure to contact us once, you will be warned. Twice, your child will be removed from the service. An \$83.95 fee for Extra Supervision re-enrolment must be paid. Hours of supervision are from 3:15pm – 5:30pm term time and 8am – 5:30pm holiday time.

12. Behaviour

Any inappropriate and/or unlawful behaviour such as damage/vandalism of our property or vehicles, abusive or offensive behaviour including but not limited to sexist and/or racist and/or bullying and/or inappropriate behaviour will result in immediate cancellation from our services. Fees will not be refunded. Any repairs, clean-up costs will be charged and will be the liability of you, the parent or guardian.

13. Summary

- 13.1. By participating, I accept all risks necessarily flowing from my participation that could result in injury. Accordingly, I release all persons or corporations associated directly or indirectly with the conduct of the event from all claims demands and proceedings arising out of my participation and I hereby indemnify them against, all liability (including liability for their negligence and negligence of others) for all injury, loss or damage arising out of

or connected with my participation in this event. This release shall extend to and include Handball Australia event organizers and their respective directors, partners, managers, officers, agents, contractors, employees and volunteers including event medical and paramedical personnel. This release and indemnity continues forever and binds my heirs, executors, personal representatives and assigns.
