FORMAT

THIS IS A 4 SQUARE COMBINED SCHOOL, TEAMS AND INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION.

A MULTIPLE COMPETITION FORMAT.

THE FORMAT CATERS FOR DIFFERENT STANDARDS, AGES AND DIFFERENT STUDENT NUMBERS.

YOU CAN WIN BOTH INDIVIDUALLY (EXAMPLE BEST STUDENT ON THEIR COURT) AND FOR YOUR SCHOOL (XYZ SCHOOL RANKED 2ND BEST).

YOU CAN WIN MULTIPLE PRIZES, NOT EVERYONE WILL RECEIVE A PRIZE, YOU MUST EARN IT.

DIVISIONS ARE SPLIT INTO YEARS (YEAR 1 -12) AND STANDARDS (BEGINNERS, INTERMEDIATE AND ADVANCED) DUE TO NUMBERS DIVISIONS MAY MERGE TOGETHER

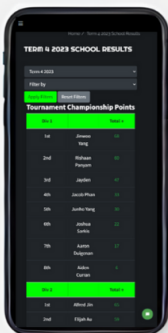



RULES



RULE	NAME	DESCRIPTION	FULL DETAILS AND EXAMPLES
1	Serve	King serves to anyone. No slack/mean serves	If a slack/mean serve is done receiver must yell out "slack or indecent" before hitting ball and ball must be served again to the same person. Receiver must be ready to receive the ball, if not ready it's a slack and ball must be served again
2	Full	Full your out	Full or Overs means ball is hit over the line into another person's square before landing in your square. You are out. There will be no Full plays or plays on's or forgotten's
3	Lines	Replay	Ball hits any line replay the point.
4	Rolls	You're out	
5	Headers	Footsies, hippies and other body parts - Allowed	Full or 1 bounce
6	Elimination	3 square elimination. Only King goes to Dunce	If you get out from Q, J or D you go to reserve.
7	Court Setup		<p>K = King Q = Queen J = Jack D = Dunce R = Reserve or Res</p> <p>Each square size approx. 2.2 x 2.2 Meters. 4 square entire court approx. 19.36 Square meters</p> <p>There can be between 2-7 students per court</p>
8	In toes or interference.	Interference from another player or ball from another court	If a ball, player or object is in the way. Player must yell "In toes or interference" before hitting the ball and point is replayed.

RULES

9	Poison	Other people can't hit into your square or they are out.	Allowed once per player during the tournament for 2 mins. Other players can't hit ball into your square until you are ready. Example tie your shoe lace, get a drink or first aid. Must be a legitimate reason. Other players can group vote to allow or deny. Game continues without your square in play. When player's move up they miss skip your square. Yell "unpoison" or "medicine" to come back into the game
10	Savies	Save a person from getting out	Yell "Savies" to save a person that was meant to be out and continue play. Player does a full, miss hits ball, hits ball out, then you can hit the ball. Player doesn't even have to hit the ball, you can hit the ball for them. You can hit the ball into their square or your square and its play on. Ball cant bounce twice before doing a savie. You can savies a line
11	Treetops	Hit ball high into the air over your opponents arms reach	Is off. You can hit the ball as high as you want. You don't have to yell treetops
12	Ghosties	Allowed to step into another person court	This is when you bork or pretend to hit the ball but don't and the ball goes into another person's square. This will confuse the other player and hopefully they get out. You are also allowed to have one foot stepping in another person's square. As long as you don't interfere with that person. You can also step out of bounds
13	Teams	This is allowed	There will be circumstances where the same team mates or school mates will be on the same court. This will give them a competitive advantage. They cannot openly discuss tactics to gesture this. But they won't try and get each other out to support their school/team ranking
14	Start position	Court start position can be done multiple ways to make it fair	Staff may say first to square, by Height, pre-ranking, DOB, First name, or staff chooses random order
15	No other rules are allowed unless majority vote	A list of Common rules that are not allowed	No death rally, no pass backs, faults, 1st serve, old King, grabsies. No Scoops, King choice. If majority of students vote to change a rule, we will, its your game, we can do any rules you want

SPORTSMANSHIP STEPS



STEP NAME DESCRIPTION FULL DETAIL AND EXAMPLES

1	Player to Player	Two Players have a healthy discussion	Both players involved in the last shot have a healthy discussion as to what might have happened without raising your voice or bullying.
2	Replay point or group Vote/Majority Vote	Players can replay point or all players can vote on what happened and who's out	If both players are unsure, the whole group of players can replay the point or do a group vote on who's out, where the ball landed or what happened.
3	Staff	Staff decides	Unsure and need help put your hand up and talk to a friendly staff member to help
4	Constant problems	Modify Rules	If staff are constantly been called to your court with disputes, crying, bullying or cheating we will modify the rules, verbal warning of players, give yellow (10 mins) and Red cards (permanently removed from competition)

ETIQUETTE & SAFETY

1. MY CHILD AND I WILL ABIDE BY HANDBALL AUSTRALIA COMPETITION RULES, ETIQUETTE, TERMS AND CONDITIONS
2. THE FOUR SPORTSMANSHIP STEPS WILL BE ADHERED TO BY ALL PLAYERS AND STAFF. MISDEMANOUR STEPS INCLUDE A KIND VERBAL WARNINGS, STRONG LOUD VOICE WARNING, MINUS POINTS, YELLOW AND RED CARDS
3. GAMESMANSHIP IS NOT ALLOWED - OPPOSITE TO SPORTSMANSHIP ON PURPOSE TRYING TO PSYCHOLOGICALLY OR MENTALLY UPSET OPPONENT TO GAIN ADVANTAGE.
4. STUDENTS AND PARENTS CAN CHEER AND BE POSITIVE. ANY BIASED OPINIONS, NEGATIVE OR RUDE REMARKS, PARENTS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE AND THEIR CHILDREN WILL BE BANNED FROM ANY FUTURE HANDBALL AUSTRALIA SERVICE AND PRODUCTS.
5. SPECTATORS MUST MAINTAIN A 2 METER DISTANCE FROM THE PLAYERS AND COURTS
6. WE TRY AND TEACH STUDENTS SPORTSMANSHIP STEPS TO RESOLVE DISPUTES. HOWEVER, PARENTS, STAFF AND COACHES MAY UMPIRE EACH COURT IF NEEDED. THIS HELPS MAINTAIN ORDER OF A COURT. IF THERE IS CONSTANT ISSUES, CONTACT STAFF AND WE ASSIST YOU
7. BATHROOM PROCESS - BEST TO GO WHEN YOUR RESERVE, WHEN YOU COME BACK YOU GO TO LAST RESERVE. GET A BUDDY FROM YOUR COURT WILL GO WITH YOU FOR SAFETY (BOTH ON POISON) IF YOU ARE IN THE COURT YELL POISON SO OTHER STUDENTS ON YOUR COURT CAN HEAR. TELL A STAFF MEMBER AND YOUR PARENTS YOU'RE GOING TO THE BATHROOM

QUESTION: IF I'M IN YEAR 3 DO I PLAY WITH YEAR 6'S

ANSWER: YES, IF YOU ARE GOOD ENOUGH YOU WILL MOVE INTO HIGHER AGE GROUPS.THE SAME GOES FOR YEAR 10'S IF THEY ARE STRUGGLING THEY CAN MOVE INTO LOWER

QUESTION: DO I HAVE TO WEAR SCHOOL SPORT UNIFORM

ANSWER: NO, YOU CAN WEAR ANY SPORTS CLOTHING. HOWEVER, THE BEST SCHOOL OR BEST GROUP AWARD GOES TO CHEERING AND SUPPORT. WEARING SCHOOL CLOTHES, FLAGS, CUSTOM MADE TEAM SHIRTS HAVE MASSIVE TEAM MORALE AND IMPACT ON THIS AWARD

QUESTION: WHAT HAPPENS IF IT RAINS AND I'M PLAYING IN AN OUTDOOR VENUE

ANSWER: YOU WILL BE SMS'D 2 HOURS BEFORE THE EVENT. A FULL REFUND OR CREDIT WILL BE MADE

QUESTION: WHAT AWARDS ARE THERE?

ANSWER: OVER 75+ TROPHIES, MEDALLIONS, HANDBALLS, PRIZES, AND CERTIFICATES.

QUESTION: CAN I WIN MULTIPLE AWARDS?

ANSWER: ANSWER: YES. YOUR SCHOOL/TEAM COULD WIN, AND YOU COULD BE THE BEST PLAYER ON YOUR COURT AND BEST SPORTSMAN. YOU GET 3 AWARDS/PRIZES. YOU DESERVE THEM

QUESTION: DOES EVERYONE GET A PRIZE/AWARD/TROPHY?

ANSWER: NO, WE ARE GENEROUS WITH OVER 75 AWARDS BUT NOT EVERYONE GETS A TROPHY, AWARD, OR PRIZE. YOU TEACH CHILDREN THAT THEY MUST EARN IT. WHEN THEY RECEIVE AN AWARD, IT MEANS A LOT MORE; THEY CHERISH IT BECAUSE THEY KNOW THEY EARNED IT

QUESTION: HOW DO YOU WIN?

ANSWER: NEW FORMAT—EVERY TIME YOU ARE IN KING AND A POINT IS OVER YOU GET A PEG. IN OTHER WORDS EVERY TIME YOU SURVIVE A POINT GET A PEG. EXAMPLE. IF DUNCE GET JACK AND YOUR IN KING GET A PEG. AFTER 1 HOUR OF PLAY, YOU MAY HAVE 46 PEG POINTS.THIS WILL GO TO YOUR INDIVIDUAL TALLY AND SCHOOL/TEAM TALLY

BONUS POINTS

CHAMPIONS OF THE COURT ADVANCED 100 INTERMEDIATE 50 BEGINNERS 10

CHEERING AND TEAM SPIRIT 10 (EACH TIME)

AFTER 1 HOUR OF PLAY, YOU MAY HAVE 46 POINTS. THIS WILL GO TO YOUR INDIVIDUAL TALLY AND SCHOOL/TEAM TALLY

QUESTION: HOW DO YOU GRADE STUDENTS

ANSWER: 5 WAYS. WE GRADE STUDENTS BASED ON PREVIOUS RESULTS, YEAR GROUPS 1-12, BY BEGINNER, INTERMEDIATE, ADVANCED ENROLMENT NOTIFICATION AND THEN FURTHER GRADING WILL HAPPEN IN THE FIRST 10 MINS OF THE WARM-UP AND FINALLY THROUGHOUT THE OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT. YOU CAN MOVE UP AND DOWN ANYTIME AND INTO ANY DIVISION AND MIX WITH ANY AGE GROUP DEPENDING ON YOUR ABILITY AT ANYTIME.

QUESTION: WHAT DO WE BRING?
